- The connections of Miso Fast accepted a bye, skipped the elimination and advanced to the Crawford Farms Meadowlands Pace Final. He drew post six in the final.
- Former New York Sires Stakes star, Miso Fast has qualified for three major stakes finals this season, the Art Rooney [sixth], North America Cup [seventh] and Max C. Hempt [fourth]. He took a new mark of 1:49.1 upsetting eventual winner Fear The Dragon in his Hempt elimination at Pocono Downs.
- In the 2016 Breeders Crown at the Meadowlands, he finished second to division champion Huntsville in his elimination and third behind that same rival in the final.
- As a freshman, Miso Fast won his first four career starts in New York Sires Stakes and finished a close second in the \$225,000 NYSS Final at Yonkers Raceway.
- Miso Fast has been driven mostly by Matt Kakaley, who has finished seventh with Rock N Roll World in 2015 and third with Check Six in 2016 in two Pace Finals.
- Matt Kakaley is a third generation horseman, following in the footsteps of his grandfather, Joe, and father, driver John Kakaley, and mother, trainer Linda Kakaley. Kakaley, 29, was born in Michigan, but spent his teen years around Pompano Park in Florida before moving to Ohio in 2007 and began his full time career as a driver. In 2010, Kakaley was voted the Rising Star Award by the U.S. Harness Writers. Now a regular driver for the Ron Burke Stable, Kakaley has almost 4,000 wins and has earned more than \$55 million in purses. Kakaley is currently among the leading drivers at Yonkers raceway and Pocono Downs.
- Ron Burke has sent out seven Pace finalists and his best finish was a third with Check Six in 2016. Burke also had the beaten favorite JK Endofanera, who finished sixth.

- Ron Burke, 47, is from Washington, PA, and started with father, Mickey Burke. Burke basically reinvented the term “mega stable” by posting record numbers, staggering statistics and an endless array of stakes stars. Burke is harness racing’s all-time leading trainer, closing in on an unprecedented 8,000 wins and recently passed the \$176 million mark. Enroute to his sixth straight training title at The Meadowlands, Team Burke is the sport’s leading stable for the ninth straight season. In 2016, the Burke Stable passed the \$21 million mark for the fourth consecutive year, sent out over 4,000 starters for the fifth straight season and dominated at several tracks.
- Miso Fast is from the second crop of 2011 Pace upsetter Roll With Joe, who just missed by a nose with his first crop in last year’s Pace with Racing Hill.
- Jerry and Theresa Silva were co-owners of two previous Pace champions, One More Laugh in 2010 and A Rock N Roll Dance in 2012.
