I have read and agree to the official contest rules & regulations

1. There are no restrictions or requirements as to the ingredients (within reason.)
2. Meadowlands Racing & Entertainment will conduct a contestant meeting at 4:30 p.m. on July 14, 2018 and provide final instructions and answer any questions.
3. Contestants must bring their own supplies, grills, cooking devices, cooking utensils, and **must have a class K fire extinguisher**. MRE will provide a cooking area for each contestant.
4. All must name NMR LLC & NJSEA as additionally insured.
5. Any food trucks or those cooking with an open flame must obtain proper fire permit.
6. Restaurant/track logo will be included on all MRE advertising for the event.
7. Vendors must be ready to serve public by 5:30 p.m. Each vendor must cook 6 BBQ samples (per category, enter any or all categories you choose) to present to the judging area at the official times for each category judging beginning at 7 p.m. (chicken 7 p.m., pulled pork 8:30 p.m., brisket 9 p.m., ribs 9:30 p.m.)
8. On the night of the contest, each contestant will be assigned a contestant's number by the Chief Scorekeeper and given an official judging plate. In order for the cook to receive the judging plate, he/she must sign the contestant

- list. Each contestant should verify that the # on the bottom of their plate is the same as their assigned contestant #. Each contestant is responsible to deliver their plate to the judging area at the official judging time for each category.
9. BBQ will be rated based on taste (50%), tenderness (35%) and appearance (15%.)
10. A maximum of 10 contestants can compete in the Meadowlands BBQ Battle. Cash prizes awarded.
11. Management decisions with respect to all of these rules and regulations shall be final and binding on all participants.
12. The following are ineligible to participate: employees of Meadowlands Racetrack (as well as owners, trainers, drivers and their agents who currently have horses racing), Ark, Funbars, Sportech, affiliated vendors or suppliers, or the immediate family of any of the previously listed.
13. MRE has the right to disqualify any entries.
14. Prizes are not transferrable and no substitution of prizes is permitted.
15. All taxes associated with the receipt or use of any prizes is the responsibility of the winner.
